On May 21, 2020, Governor Kay Ivey updated the Alabama Proceeding with Caution Order regarding restrictions on individual and business activities due to COVID-19. The new Order goes into effect on May 22, 2020 and ends July 3, 2020. Highlights of the Order are noted below.

Individuals

- Encouraged to stay home and follow good sanitation practices

Businesses

- May open subject to social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Retail Stores

- May open at 50 percent occupancy
- Must follow social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Restaurants, Bars and Breweries

- May open with limited seating capacity
- Must maintain six feet of distance between tables
- Sanitation guidelines must be followed

Athletic Facilities

- May open subject to social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Non-Work Gatherings

- Must still maintain six feet of distance between members of different households

Beaches

- May open with no limit on the number of individuals in gatherings
- Must maintain six feet of distance between members of different households

Entertainment Venues such as Movie Theaters and Bowling Alleys

- May reopen subject to social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Athletic Activities

- Practices are allowed as of May 23rd
- Competitions may resume June 15th
- Social distancing and sanitation guidelines must be followed

Close-Contact Service Providers such as Hair and Nail Salons

- May open subject to social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Educational Institutions

- May reopen June 1st subject to social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Child Day Care Facilities

- May open subject to social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Summer Camps

- May operate subject to social distancing and sanitation guidelines

Senior Citizen Centers and Programs

- Services must remain suspended
- Curbside meal pickup services encouraged

Hospital and Nursing Homes

- Visitation must still be restricted

Medical Procedures

- Allowed unless limited by State Health Officer
